Judy's recent work as the Board Of Management and Summer Committee Treasurer brought a much needed lift in the level of professionalism and attention to detail and visibility required for the Club to function and meet its compliance obligations.

When Judy took over there was a backlog of about 7 years returns that she was required to sort out and submit - without a lot of help from anyone else.

Following through on the ongoing billing issues that inevitably arise with BV (discounts, team entries, unpaid subscriptions, fines) KCC ground rentals, Grant acquittals, Utilities discounts, over charging..., compliance reporting, Bendigo Bank (signatures and authorisations). Her Budget also serves as schedule for when important bills need to be paid.

By taking her duties very seriously Judy has reduced our risk exposure to theft and fraudulent behaviour and reduced our costs by careful management of our cash flows by making the financials visible and by insisting on proper and timely processes. (e.g.: Receipts and 2 people to sign off).

Without the sound financial base, that Judy has established our Club would simply cease to operate.

She has big shoes to fill and we seriously do not know how we would replace her when it comes her time to retire.

As an estimate, we believe that Judy has scored over 500 + games for the Club and served for 25+ years on Committee.
