Michael Trevorah was a Club personality and a Legend. He played in our Firsts as a catcher between 1973 and 1985. Rock solid behind the plate, he had the essential ability to set up hitters and establish a strong rapport with his pitchers along with an arm that kept the base runners honest.

Michael was one of the best bunters the Club has ever had and he thrived on laying down the squeeze bunt even though he regularly hit for high averages. In 1975 Mick batted .411 and set a Club record by recording 6 hits in a game against Footscray, a record that remains to this day.

Following his retirement as a first nine player, Trevorah continued to be heavily involved at all levels, coaching senior men and women's teams as well as Club and DBA junior representative sides, always with considerable success. Many of the pennants hanging from the walls in the pavilion are down to Michael and his teams.

Michael was recognised as one of the Club's finest 50 players at our Century Celebrations in 2014.





Off the field Michael was always a major contributor and over many decades he served effectively in many senior executive positions including that Chairman of the Board and Summer President and also as the Chairman of Selectors.

Michael's passion and commitment to the Club and his unwavering support of all members was always clearly evident to those who knew him.
