Dear Kim,

I wish to nominate TREVOR HOGBEN as a Life Member of the Cheltenham Baseball Club Inc.

He has given service to the Club both on and off the field since joining in 1972. He was 12 years of age when he first played in the Dandenong Baseball Association Competition for Cheltenham, playing in the Under 13 competition for one year and subsequently in the Under 15 and Under 17 teams.

He was a member of the Under 17 team selected to play in the Victorian Provincial Baseball League Junior Championships in both 1975 and 1976, and in the Colts side in 1977 and 1978.

In the 1976 D.B.A. competition, the Under 17 Cheltenham team was successful in defeating Noble Park 12/0 to win the Grand Final. Trevor had three safe hits for the game, including 2 triples, also pitching throughout the game.

In 1975 he commenced playing Senior Baseball and whilst still in the Under 17's, pitched in the opening game of the 1976 winter competition for A Grade; from then on he was a regular member of the A Grade team. In 1976 he also played in the V.B.A. Summer Competition Division 1 and continued to play both Summer and Winter baseball with Cheltenham since.

In 1983 he was appointed A Grade Coach and was Coach of the Club for the 1986 and 1987 Seasons. In 1987 the A Grade, A 2 and C 1 sides were all Premiers. The A Grade had made 5 consecutive Grand Final appearances, but it was the first A Grade Premiership for 14 years.

Trevor played in one B Grade Premiership side, and in nine A Grade Grand Finals being Premiers twice.

Trevor has also served the Club well as part of both The Executive and General Committees.

He was Secretary in 1982 and 1983 and ^{x 1984} Committee Member 1986, 1987 and 1988. Vice-President, Social Club Chairman and Bar Manager in 1991.

He has shown over these 20 years that he is a true and loyal club member and has many trophies to demonstrate how he has always 'put in' at team level.
